Kindergarten

- _ book bag - labeled with your child's name (*no rolling book bags*)
- _ a towel or small blanket labeled with your child's name
- _ 3 packages of crayons (24 count)
- _ 24 glue sticks
- _ 1 pencil pouch (with a zipper)
- _ 2 packages of pencils
- _ 1 plain folder with pockets (no plastic folders please)
- _ 2 large pink erasers (or any other color)
- _ 2 Primary Journal composition notebooks (stage 3)
- _ 2 spiral notebooks
- _ 1 pack of 5 tab dividers
- _ a change of clothing (labeled in a Zip-Lock bag, including socks and undergarments) in case of an accident
- _ Boys bring an 8 pack of broad tipped markers (classic colors)
- _ Girls bring a package of colored pencils

* We will label all school supplies in the classroom.

First Grade

- 1 book bag – labeled with your child's name NO ROLLING BOOK BAGS
- 1 wooden or plastic clipboard
- 1 plastic pencil box
- 2 packs of pencils (plain yellow)
- 1 pair of blunt tip scissors
- 6 glue sticks
- 4 vinyl or plastic folders with pockets (no brads)
- 1 paper folder with brads
- 1 1 ½ inch colored binder (No Trapper Keepers, please)
- 6 wide tip dry erase markers (blue, black, or red)
- 2 boxes of crayons (16 in each box)

We will take up supplies of pencils, crayons, folders etc... and they will be used at school. These will be given out as needed for use in class. You may want to purchase additional supplies for your child to use at home.

Second Grade

- 1 yellow plastic folder (**with pockets**)
- 1 orange plastic folder (**with pockets**)
- Glue Sticks (12)
- Spiral Notebooks (3)
- Highlighters (1 pack)
- Notebook Paper (4 packs, wide ruled)
- Crayons (1 package of 16)
- Cap Erasers (1 pack)
- Index Cards (2 packs 3x5, white, lined)
- Pencils (3 packs)
- Black Expo Markers (4 thin)
- Paper Plates (1 pack)
- Book Bag (NO ROLLING BOOK BAGS PLEASE)
- Ziplock Bags (1 box of small and 1 box of large)

☺ Please note that this list is just to get us started. We will be sending home a reminder in December to replenish your child's supplies. ☺ Please, do not send Trapper Keepers or art supply boxes. We do not have enough room in our desks for these with our textbooks.

Third Grade

- 1 ½" binder NO LARGE CLOTH BINDERS
- 8 tab dividers
- 3 packs of #2 lead pencils
- 2-one subject spiral bound notebook (any color or design)
- 1 pack of pencil top erasers
- 4 glue sticks
- scissors
- highlighters
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 5 packs wide-ruled notebook paper
- zippered pencil pouch
- Expo Dry Erase markers
- 5 Jumbo Book Sox or book covers
- ruler

Fourth and Fifth Grade

We encourage purchasing supplies, such as paper and pencils, at “back to school prices” to be able to replenish your child's supplies throughout the school year.

- Three ring binder - 2 inch rings or larger

- 8-10 packages of loose-leaf notebook paper (no tablets please) this amount will last through the year
