 - a. File Form after parents complete Tax return information
 - b. Cannot be submitted before January 1st, 2007
 - c. Request PIN in December.
 - d. Used for federal and state aid (i.e. HOPE Scholarship)

 - a. Student must be on track to graduate with his/her graduating class and earn at least 2.5 credits the previous semester in order to be eligible in extracurricular activities.
