



United Streaming: A Digital Video Library...and more!



Getting Started:

1. Obtain your passcode from your Media Specialist.
2. Use your web browser to go to www.unitedstreaming.com
3. Enter your passcode.
4. Fill in the required information to set up your own account with a user name and password.

Viewing Videos:

1. Once logged in, you may search by keyword, subject and grade, curriculum standard, or all available titles.

2. A list of videos will appear or you may click to see articles, images, etc.

- There will now be a list short video clips that you may click on to view by streaming (s), to download (d), or to add to your playlist (a).



(To Download the file, Right Click on the “d,” then choose Save Target As. Choose where you want it saved and click Save. NOTE: *Please read “Terms of Use” [link at the bottom of each page] and comply.)

(To Add to Your Playlist, click on the “2,” then select a playlist or click on Create New Playlist and complete the information and click Add New Playlist. Then select the playlist and click the Select Playlist button.)

Playlists:

This is your ‘Favorites’ list.



- Click on **Playlist** on the top toolbar.
- Click on **Add a New Playlist**.



- Complete the information and click **Add New Playlist**.
- Repeat to add as many lists as you would like.

****Once you have created the playlist, you may add videos to your playlists.**

The Teacher Center has Interactive Training, a schedule of Web Seminars (Webinars), 1 – 2 minute tutorials on using United Streaming, a Newsletter, etc.

- The Quiz Center allows you to create quizzes or use quizzes that others have created and shared.



Create a New Quiz or Search for one using the tools on the left. The Create New Quiz wizard will take you through a 4 step process. If you search and find one you like, you may copy it to your quiz list.



5. The Lesson Plans are organized by grade level and subject area.

Click the category or grade range to view Lesson Plans in their respective areas, or click a button to view Lesson Plans specific to that subject/grade combination.
